

Instructions

Materials Needed:

1. Cutout page attached to this document or white paper to draw words DAD
2. Paint
3. Canvas
4. Tape
5. Black marker
6. Pencil
7. scissors

Preparation before working with a child under age 10.

- Prep step 1: cut out the DAD stencil - even if you draw your own it needs to be cut out. The centers of letters A and D should be cut out as well.
- Prep step 2: tape the stencil to a canvas. Only the letters D A D should be taped down, discard the rest of the cutout.

What the child needs to do:

Part 1: Paint the canvas- including the taped-down word dad.

Part 2: After canvas is dried - add a handprint to the top of the painting. Choose a color not used in the painting.

The final step before gifting:

Best done by an adult or child over the age of 10 with good pencil skills.

1. Removed the taped-down word, DAD. Revealing a white outline of the word.
2. Trace the word DAD on the CANVAS with a black marker.

Bonus: Use white paint to cover any edges where paint got under the stencil
